Cigarette butts and electronic cigarette waste contain a variety of chemicals and materials that are hazardous to the environment when they are disposed of improperly.

These products can still contain nicotine, lead, and other chemicals after an individual is done using them. These materials can be washed into nearby bodies of water from rain runoff. When local wildlife drink from these bodies of water, or attempt to eat things like cigarette butts, they are poisoned by the chemicals. This can be fatal for the animal, and if it is not fatal, it can cause other problems such as vomiting and seizures.

In addition to chemical hazards, the cigarette and e-cigarettes themselves are detrimental to the environment. These products are made from plastic and are not biodegradable. They can leach microplastics into the environment, which end up in our waterways and food supply.

This Earth Day, we encourage you to partner with your communities and participate in community clean up drives. It is also encouraged to check with your local recycling or waste management facilities for guidance on the safe disposal of cigarettes and e-cigarette materials. **Whose ID Do I Check? What Do I Look For?**

WHICH ITEM?	WHOSE ID?	WHAT DO I LOOK FOR?
TOBACCO PRODUCTS	All Customers	Photo (Matches customer.) Date of birth (Customer is 21 years old or older.)
E-CIGARETTES	Customers who look younger than 30 years old	Expiration date (ID is not expired.) ID looks real; doesn't look fake.
