How do I access eBooks?

Membership, which is \$10 for the year, is required for access to eBooks and other services.

Provide us with your email address, and we will create a User ID. We will send you detailed instructions on how to create an account and which link to use to access eBooks. Our eBook vendor, Ebsco, will send a link for you to create an account. You will then follow the instructions that we sent to you.

Should I contact Ebsco with questions?

What kind of software do I need installed on my computer to read eBooks?

Browser: Mozilla Firefox, Google Chrome or Internet Explorer 10.0 or later.

Adobe Acrobat Reader DC – free on <http://www.adobe.com/products/reader.html>

What kinds of eBooks do you offer?

Yes, you may print up to 60 pages of the eBook. You may also **save** and **email** (as a pdf) up to 60 pages of the eBook.
